Letter from Pastor Hayley

It has been five years since I came here as your pastor. Now I reflect on those past five years with all of their joys and sadness, including the unexpected pandemic still upon us.

Do you remember my first sermon here back in 2016? Most of you will say, "Pastor, I don't remember what I did last week, and you're asking me about a sermon five years ago?" Perhaps that is true. But I'm not asking if you remember the whole sermon, I'm asking if you remember the question I asked as we began our ministry journey together. In my sermon I said, "We have many hopes and dreams for the future together. We hope only positive things will happen, but we cannot guarantee that. 
