## Indoor Worship to Resume March 14th

At February's Council Meeting, the Council voted to resume indoor worship services beginning on March 14, 2021, at 10:30 am. For those who feel more comfortable worshiping at home, Pastor Hayley will record the service and will have it available after worship. (You will receive an email when it is available.)

For those who do not have internet, I will continue to mail weekly worship materials.

Below are the guidelines that we will follow for the health and well-being of all of us.

- Upon entering the church, your temperature will be taken.
- Only the first time that you attend will you be asked to complete a health questionnaire.
- Attendance will be taken at each service.

- Maintain 6 feet of distance from others – exceptions are made if you are from the same family and living under the same roof.
- You must wear a mask over your mouth and nose at all times while in the church building.
- Singing and verbal responses will be limited and done in a soft voice.
- Socializing is not permitted inside the building, before or after worship.

Please adhere to the above guidelines. It is our way of living as faithful neighbors and fellow siblings in Christ where we care for our own and each other's lives.

Let us pray that by following the above protocol, worship in the church will continue!

#### **Letter from Pastor Hayley**

Here we are again at the beginning of the season of Lent, a time of contemplation and reflection.

As we reflect, we realize this is our second Lent during the pandemic. We could've never imagined that we'd be in the same situation that we were a year ago. However we do have hope for this new year, which is in fact different from this time last year. Vaccines have been approved, including a third one just recently, and people are starting to get vaccinated.

In light of this good news, the Council and I have decided to move forward and reevaluate the way we gather for worship.

Once again we are planning an indoor service. We will worship again in the sanctuary starting March 14th.

Here is a reminder of the rules and regulations we have put into place in order to be able to gather physically and yet worship safely together.

- Remain in your car until you see an usher outside the church door.
- Upon entering the church your temperature will be taken, and you will be asked to complete a health questionnaire. You will only have to complete the questionnaire once. After that, each week the usher will ask you whether or not anything has changed from the previous week.
- Based upon the mandated guidelines, we are allowed 50% capacity. However our sanctuary is too small to have 50% capacity and still remain socially distant, so if we

exceed our capacity you will be asked to proceed to the Family Room to listen to the service.

- Please maintain 6 feet from others.
   Exceptions are made for members of the same family and those living under the same roof.
- You must wear a mask over your nose and mouth at all times while in the church building.
- Singing or verbal responses will be with very minimal voice.
- The restrooms will not be available for use.
- Windows will be open before and during the worship service to allow proper ventilation....dress accordingly.
- Only open your own pre-filled communion cups/wafers — do not assist others.
- Socializing is not permitted inside the building before and/or after worship.
- You will be given a brown paper bag to put your bulletin and communion trash in. Please take your own trash home. It is not to be commingled with other worshippers.

Please adhere to the above guidelines. It is our way of living as faithful neighbors and fellow siblings in Christ, where we care for our own and each other's lives. I am looking forward to meeting you in person again safely.
